
# A story in a cube

#### **Instructions:**

You're going to build a paper cube to talk about a story you've read. On each side of the cube, you will write a small texts by hand to present:

- the main character
- the place and the time of the story
- a summary
- your appreciation

You will also make a drawing that illustrates the story.



#### <u>Steps:</u>

#### 1. READ

You have the choice of reading short stories online on the Shortedition site<sup>1</sup>, or reading a short novel ("chapter book") if you have one at home. IMPORTANT: You need to read at least 4x15 minutes !

## 2. PREPARE

In your notebook (or on your iPad), write the draft of each text you'll write on the sides of the cube, including the title and the author.

Use the support sheet and the example on the class site to help you.

# 3. CREATE

With a pen, write each text neatly on the template of the cube.

Useful tip: if you have to redo a text, print the cube template again, then cut and glue the side with the text you rewrote only.

Possible adaptation: - uses the template with larger sides

- uses a well-sharpened pencil (instead of a pen)

## 4. BUILT AND PUBLISH

Delicately, and if possible with the help of an adult, cut out the cube template, then fold and glue the tabs.

Last, take a picture of each side of your cube, and post them on Freshgrade..
