

# "Oratory Art presentation"

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Step 1: WRITE

1. Choose my **subject** – see examples  
*Suggestion: a topic you already know a little!*
2. Complete the **preparation sheet** with what you know  
(and, if possible, with personal examples)
3. Do a **research** to complete your ideas and find more details and explanations.  
*Use Internet or ask an adult.*
4. Write a **3-part draft** on the computer or in the text book  
(see "*Feuille d'aide*") )
5. Read my text (for myself or another person), then try to make **improvements** (for ideas) or **corrections** (with French language)
6. Complete **the self-assessment (1)** and, if necessary, make further **changes** to improve my text..
7. *Publish my text on **Freshgrade***  
*Attention: no later than Friday, June 12th!*



### Step 2: ORAL PRESENTATION

1. **Highlight the most important** ideas, words or sentences in the text
2. **Learn** the text by heart (or be able to say it without hesitation)
3. **Practice** my presentation (alone, in front of a friend or a parent)
4. **Film** my presentation with my iPad, then do my **self-assessment (2)**
5. **Practice while** still trying to improve **myself** (speed, volume, hesitation, etc.)
6. Presentation dates:

- Student AT HOME: **Wednesday, June 17** (on Zoom between 10-11am)
- Students AT SCHOOL: **Thursday, June 18** (in class, between 10-11am)
