"My awesome box!" A creative project to work on thinking skills

Instruction:

From a simple cardboard box, you're going to have to create a new object. In other words, you're going to turn a box into something else: a robot, a room, a car, an instrument, a game, etc. - see examples in attachment.

You will thus have to cut, paste, and add elements to the box (pieces of cardboard, fabric, string, container, buttons, etc.) in order to create the best possible new object.

But the important thing in this project is not so much the finished product (what you do) as much as the CREATION PROCESS (how you do it). Therefore throughout the project, you're going to have to take the time to stop and think about what and how you're doing.

There will be 3 moments when you have to write and draw your reflections: BEFORE you start building, DURING construction, and AFTER construction.
